#TakePrEPTakeCharge campaign aims to increase awareness about the availability of PrEP for cisgender women (**#prep4women**).

PrEP (pre-exposure prophylaxis) is an HIV prevention method that is safe and is about 99% effective for reducing the risk of getting HIV from sex when taken as prescribed. Women account for 1 in 5 new HIV diagnoses in New Jersey, and the disease most impacts communities of color (AIDSVu, 2021). Primarily marketed to men, most women do not know that PrEP is a viable HIV prevention option that is discreet, self-controlled, and widely available for them, too. Through this awareness campaign targeting Black and Hispanic/Latina women living in New Jersey, we hope to increase the number of women who know that PrEP is also for them.

Purpose of this toolkit

To introduce partner organizations, advocates, and consumers to #TakePrEPTakeCharge and increase awareness about #prep4women among their networks via social media. We hope to empower women to take charge of their sexual health and encourage more dialogue about HIV prevention options with their providers.




